

He and his wife Cindy will celebrate their 45th Wedding Anniversary June 5th and live in Whitmore Lake, MI. Cindy is retired from full time work as a Speech Therapist and now gets to watch 8-month-old granddaughter Amelia two days each week. We are blessed to have 3 wonderful adult children and 3 grandchildren—including Ella (11) and Luke (9) in Bowling Green, OH. In the warmer months they enjoy kayaking, bike riding and fishing.

Pastor Scott has a passion for leadership development, helping home and congregation work together to enrich the faith of every generation, as well as organizational/relational health founded on Holy Manners and Servant Leadership. He graduated from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis in 1987 and completed his Doctor of Ministry degree there in 2007. While his business card reads Rev. Dr. Scott G. 

Raise the Roof for Risen Christ School!

THANK YOU to ALL who have contributed and/or pledged to our “Raise the Roof for Risen Christ School” fundraising campaign. These funds will finance rooms for the school’s middle grades AND church pantry, as well as expanding the kitchen to support the church’s hot meals program. To date, \$1,150,000 has been donated/pledged. Along with the school’s reserve fund, it is possible to move forward with the building program. However, the school’s reserve funds must be replaced. Additional donations are still desired. A bridge loan has been approved to cover the cost until the pledges are received.

Preparations for construction by Kapp Construction Company have been completed. A map of underground utilities has been completed as well as soil boring to determine if additional support would be needed for the foundation.

More opportunities are available to contribute to this important project. Look for the restaurant schedule (dates and places where a percentage of intake is given to Risen Christ), information about the calendar special events donations, donate through the QR code or by an envelope stating the contribution is for the “Raise the Roof” fund.


